

Winter Bouldering League Rules & Info.

Qualifying Rounds

- i. The format of the qualifying round is based on the standard bouldering league format, i.e. 20 problems to be attempted within a set time period with no isolation.
- ii. Each problem has a pre-designated starting position, consisting of two fixed positions for both hands.
- iii. A successful first attempt is worth 10 points, a successful second attempt is worth 7 points, a successful third attempt is worth 4 points and a successful attempt in 4 or more attempts is worth 1 point. Holding the bonus hold is worth 1 point. This point does not get added to the score if you successfully complete the problem.
- iv. There are 5 rounds in total, with a final (held straight after the 5th round) for the 5 highest ranked competitors of each category based on scores over your 4 highest scoring rounds.

Final

- i. The final shall consist of 4 problems for each category with 4 minutes climbing time per problem.
- ii. The fixed quota for the final round shall be 5.
- iii. The scoring systems for the final is:
 - Number of Tops,
 - Number of Bonus',
 - Attempts to Top,
 - Attempts to Bonus.
